## **Returned Emigrants Network**

In December 2023 we held the first meeting of our **Returned Emigrants Network** in Portlaoise, Co. Laois and the Network has met bi-monthly since then. Returning to Ireland after living abroad for many years can be both an exciting and a challenging experience. Some people return in a planned fashion and can navigate the return and re-settlement process with ease. However, we know some people return in challenging situations (due to a myriad of reasons) and find the return process guite daunting, emotionally and practically. We have set up the Returned Emigrants Network to address some of the issues and challenges faced on return and where possible advocate for policy change. The Network is also intended as a place for people to meet others who have lived abroad and returned.

Our next Returned Emigrants Network will take place on Saturday 17th August in Portlaoise Library (2-3.30pm). We welcome people from Laois and all around Ireland if you can travel!

#### **Board Recruitment**

Following a recent governance review and to ensure effective succession planning, we are currently seeking to appoint new Directors for our Board.
